PUBLIC NOTIFICATION



LPS Protocols for COVID-19 Response

When the District receives notification of a positive case:

1. Person who tests positive is quarantined for at least 10 days **and** until non-symptomatic for at least 24 hours.
2. LPS initiates contact tracing to determine if there are any "close contacts", with guidance and assistance from Wayne County Health Dept.
3. Close contacts* are personally notified by district personnel; those individuals must quarantine for 14 days from last date of contact, whether or not they are tested.
4. Strict cleaning protocols are completed at the site.
5. Written communications are sent via email to the school community (staff and families).
6. Public notice is added to this site within 24 hours of confirmation by the Wayne County HD.
7. School remains in session for the following day unless otherwise determined in consultation with the WC Health Dept and announced by the district.

**Close contact is defined as having been within 6 ft. of the individual who tested positive for at least 15 consecutive minutes or more.*
