

NHS EXPECTATIONS

These are National and School expectations to remain a member of National Honor Society. We will review how each member is doing each semester. If you do not meet expectations, you will be placed on probation for a marking period. If you do not remedy the situation in one marking period, you will be removed from our chapter.

YOU MUST:

1. **Maintain a 3.5 GPA**
2. **Citizenship grades of 1's and 2's.**
3. **Miss no more than 2 meetings throughout the year.**
Meetings are the 1st Tuesday of each month. (Second Tuesday if school is not in session during the first Tuesday.)
4. **Help with tutoring within the school.**
This includes attending Freshmen Cookies and Cram, as well as math lab or other tutoring in the school. You should complete at least 2 hours of tutoring each semester.
5. **Participate in at least one chapter community service event each semester.**
These events are put on by our chapter a few times each semester.
6. **Complete 30 hours of community service each year.**
This may include tutoring and chapter events. No more than 10 hours can be from the summer and the hours should be split between semesters. Example: 10 hours summer, 10 hours 1st semester, and 10 hours 2nd semester.
7. **Adhere to the NHS Bylaws and School Policies.**
8. **Remain actively involved in at least one other school club, sport, or organization.**
9. **Earn 20 points per year in order to: continue as a member (junior to senior) or have the option of purchasing an honor cord to wear during the commencement ceremony if you are a senior.**
10. **Pay a one-time membership fee of \$20.**

***Any disciplinary issues will be reviewed by faculty council to remain active.
