Daily Class Schedule

Students in Livonia Public Schools were able to participate in one of two programs this year: face-to-face (F2F) or Livonia Virtual. Students who selected the F2F program will begin the year remotely (online) and transition to in-person learning in October.

Students will also be assigned an Academic Learning Lab (ALL) activity by each teacher, which is approximately a 60-minute weekly asynchronous activity to be completed by the student. There is not a formal time assigned to this; it is meant to be flexible and on the student's schedule.

*Synchronous: Learning that happens in “real time” or in-the-moment.

*Asynchronous: During this time, teachers will work with students in small groups and provide one-on-one support as students complete assignments, or students will complete work independently.
