

2nd Grade Home-Learning Activities!


Our new lesson plan format will include new teaching, each day of the week in different areas.

Typically you will find:


Reading/Literacy/Science- Monday and Wednesday

It is called, "Can you put that word in a song?"</p> <p>Decide what words to use. I suggest 5 different words per person. Then - you show the word...and the person seeing the word for the first time has to sing a song that has that same word in it. If no song comes to mind, make up a short song and sing it with that word. Now, it might seem that adults would have the better chances due to age and the volume of songs we have heard over the years. BUT...don't count out my students! Disney songs hold a vast amount of words (especially the movie Tangled...)</p> <p>Watch Claire Crosby and her Dad try this.
