



Good Afternoon LPS Families,

We would like to share a few informational items with you today, as we wrap up the week. Communications have been flowing via email from each school in the district, in an effort to keep you informed of this very unique start to the school year.

Please continue to monitor your email inbox. If you are not receiving emails from the schools or the district, please contact your school secretary, who will be able to troubleshoot the issue via the MiStar student information system. As a reminder, the district posts all Return to Learn updates and communications to the website at www.livoniapublicschools.org/return.

Today, we have information regarding the timeline for teacher assignments, class schedules and the daily time schedules for “in-person/remote start” as well as Livonia Virtual. We are also excited to share a student meal program that will be offered during the Safe Start September to both “in-person/remote start” students and Livonia Virtual students.

Teacher Assignments / Class Schedules

Teacher / classroom assignments and class schedules (for in-person/remote start and Livonia Virtual) will be posted on Parent Connect by 1 p.m. on Thursday, September 3. While we know everyone is anxious to receive schedules and teacher assignments, all classes and student schedules had to be reestablished following the Livonia Virtual registration period. Thank you for your patience.

Important note: **Before Thursday**, please be sure that you are able to log in to Parent Connect. See instructions below:

How do I sign in to Parent Connect?

If you do not know your login information click on "Need Your Login Information?"

Type in the email address that is listed on your child's pink emergency card. If your email has changed you must contact your school office to have this updated.

Check your email inbox for information from Parent Connect. You should receive your "PIN" (series of numbers) and password.

TIP: In your contacts on your phone, list your PIN and password under "Parent Connect."

✓ Please note, school offices will be open Monday – Thursday next week, but will be closed on Friday, Sept. 4.

Daily Time Schedules

The structure of the school day for both “in-person/remote start” and Livonia Virtual will be shared with parents on Monday, August 31. Please monitor your email on Monday morning for specific daily time schedules for each level. These schedules will describe the times for synchronous (live) instruction and asynchronous (self-guided) learning.

Information regarding the “how-to’s” of the remote start and Livonia Virtual will be communicated by the schools. This information will give parents and students specifics on how to access Google classrooms, virtual meeting links, etc. The district is also preparing “Professional Development for Parents,” so everyone is comfortable supporting their student(s) through their remote learning platform.

Remember, the district will begin the school year on Tuesday, September 8 remotely, through the month of September. We are planning for a return to in-person learning beginning at the start of October. Our district will be closely monitoring data in our region, while remaining in close contact with our Intermediate School District and the Wayne County Health Department as we plan for the return of our students following Safe Start September. As shared previously, we will utilize a phased-in approach for in-person return, which will be communicated prior to that time. We realize that such “unknowns” can be unsettling for parents, students and staff, but we are confident that to “go fast, we must go slow” for the sake of the health and safety of all. We appreciate your patience, your trust and your partnership as we navigate this challenging time together.

Safe Start September Meals

Lastly, we are happy to offer school breakfasts and lunches during Safe Start September.

The program will work differently than during the spring shutdown. Parents/guardians may order meals via an order form, linked below, and the meals may be picked up at

the school location of your choice. For example, if you live near Grant Elementary, but your child attends Webster Elementary, you may select Grant as your pickup location.

Meals will be free for those who received free lunches last school year through the federal free and reduced lunch program; and the reduced price meals are also valid. Students who are not eligible for free/reduced meals but would like to purchase meals may do so as well. The meal program is open to any student, and payment for non-free meals must be made via the My Payments Plus link: <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com/welcome>

Meal pick-up will be daily at your selected location between 11:15 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Students may pick up meals without a parent/guardian; neighbors may pick up for neighbors, if they provide the full names of the children for whom the meals are intended.

Prices are the same as the normal food service program:

Elementary (Grades K-6)

- Breakfast Full Price \$1.75
- Breakfast Reduced Price \$0.30
- Lunch Full Price \$3.25
- Lunch Reduced Price \$0.40
- Free lunch eligible meals. FREE

Secondary (Grades 7-12)

- Breakfast Full Price \$1.75
- Breakfast Reduced Price \$0.30
- Lunch Full Price \$3.75
- Lunch Reduced Price \$0.40
- Free lunch eligible meals. FREE

Due to logistics, there will be some limitations.

- We are offering breakfasts and lunches together as one order. We cannot split the order to only include breakfast or only include lunch.
- When ordering meals, the order must be for the entire duration of the program (Sept. 9-30). One form submission will be for the entire duration of the program.
- We will not be able to accommodate changes in pick-up locations. The location specified on the form cannot be changed. We appreciate your understanding.
