As you know, the Board of Education approved our Safe Start September plan with the intention to return to in-person instruction in October. Teams of staff, administrators and union leadership have been meeting and creating plans for a safe return to in-person instruction.

The plans will be discussed at the Board of Education's committee meeting, which is set for 6:30 p.m. on Monday, September 21. The meeting will be held in person in the Board meeting room at the LPS Administration Building, located at 15125 Farmington Road. We will provide limited overflow in a nearby conference room, with a video feed. However, please know that the meeting will be broadcast live on cable TV (Spectrum channel 215 and channel 19 on Comcast) and recorded and posted on the district website on Tuesday (School Board tab). We will also provide a live stream of the meeting on Youtube (find this link on the district website on Monday -- School Board tab, then Meeting Information).

We encourage all families to watch this board meeting in order to hear the proposed plans and the board discussion. A summary of the proposed plans will be provided to families via email on Tuesday, September 22. The board is expected to vote on the proposal during its regular meeting on Monday, September 28.
