

# Livonia Virtual is a “GO!” for 2021-22



The following is a breakdown of Livonia Virtual program changes at the middle school and high school level. We are pleased to again offer the flexible learning option for next school year.



## This Year 2020-2021



- Students were able to select LV or in-person instruction at two points during the school year
- LV class sessions are synchronous and asynchronous
- The LV school day is in a block schedule of six classes over two days
- In-person and LV daily time schedules are not matched
- A one-hour asynchronous time for all students allowed for an early dismissal time (1:15 p.m. middle school and 1:55 p.m. for FHS, SHS and 2:00 p.m. CHS)
- Several LV students were able to select a combination of LV and in-person classes
- Many specialized program courses (magnet programs, performance-based courses, lab-intensive courses) were able to be offered in LV this year

## Next Year 2021-2022



- • Students will have one opportunity to select LV or in-person instruction and that decision will be for the entire school year
- • LV class sessions will be all synchronous (live virtual instruction)
- • The LV school day will be six classes each day (traditional six-period day)
- • LV and in-person daily time schedules will be matched up, at each level
- • The one-hour asynchronous period will be eliminated and the school day will return to its traditional length
- • LV students will only be able to select LV courses
- • Specialized programs, magnet programs, performance-based and lab-intensive courses will only be offered in person

*As was the case this year, Livonia Career Technical Center (LCTC) courses will not be offered in LV.*
