

Livonia Virtual is a “GO!” for 2021-22



The following is a breakdown of Livonia Virtual (LV) program changes at the elementary level. We are pleased to again offer the flexible learning option for next school year.



This Year 2020-2021



- Students were able to select LV or in-person instruction at two points during the school year
- LV class sessions are live and self-guided
- The LV school day has three hours of live and three hours of asynchronous instruction.
- In-person and LV daily time schedules are not matched
- Self-guided work included a 30-minute i-Ready session for all students, which allowed for an early dismissal time
- When enrollment was sufficient, an LV option was offered for magnet programs.

Next Year 2021-2022



- Students will have one opportunity to select LV or in-person instruction and that decision will be for the entire school year
- LV class sessions are live and self-guided
- The LV school day is 6 hours and 15 minutes. The LV school day includes core academic subjects, specials and small group time.
- In-person and LV daily time schedules are not matched.
- The self-guided work will be posted as needed in the Google Classroom, and is a continuation of direct instruction
- Magnet programs at the elementary level (ACAT/Niji-Iro) will only be offered in-person due to the unique aspects of these programs.
