- Monitoring work completion and providing a quiet time and place for schoolwork that is free from distractions
- Assisting your child in returning work, books and other school materials as well as picking up necessary materials from the school
- Allowing students to work independently on assignments and assessments unless prearranged supports are set up with the LPS staff
- Attending virtual parent/teacher conferences and contacting the teacher and/or principal if their child is experiencing difficulty
- Staying informed about their child's education, reading all communications from the teacher, school and the school district and responding as appropriate
- Following guidelines set forth in the Elementary Student Handbook
- Having positive, genuine, supportive, professional, kind, reflective, empathetic and thoughtful interactions with all members of our school community

Students of Livonia Virtual are expected to:

- Attend virtual sessions on time and be ready to work hard and try their best
- Have necessary materials organized appropriately for all assignments and complete assignments on time
- Have their camera on at all times and participate to the best of their ability
