



COVID-19 Close Contact & Quarantine Summary for Families

If your student has been identified as a close contact to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, the following process would occur, in order to prevent spread within the school setting.

A close contact is an individual who has been within 3 feet, masked or unmasked, for 15 minutes of an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Quarantine of a close contact is NOT required if:

- The student has been fully vaccinated, two weeks post second dose, and verifies with a COVID-19 vaccination card

OR

- The student can show a confirmatory COVID-19 positive PCR test within the past 5 months

When quarantine is required, the following will occur:

- Quarantine (stay home from school and school activities) for 10 days
- Exception: The student may return on day 8 of his/her quarantine, if all three of these occur:
 - » They receive a PCR test within 24 hours of day 7
 - » If the PCR test is negative AND the student is asymptomatic
- Student will have assignments posted daily via the teacher's Google classroom. The teacher will communicate with the student via a web-based meeting or a phone call on the first full day of quarantine, and a second contact will be made during quarantine.
- The student will also be contacted at least two times during his/her quarantine by the building administrator and/or his/her mental health designee (SAP, Counselor, EST, ESAP) to check on the student's social emotional well-being, with the first contact within 2 days of the start of his/her quarantine.
