It's okay if you don't spell the word correctly, just write the sounds you hear. Draw pictures to match the red fruit. Then use the red fruit words and put them into a sentence using the prompt: I see the _____.</p> <p><b>Reminder when your child is writing: Have your child stretch out the tricky words and they write the sounds they hear. Word wall words should have good spelling, but other words they should use kindergarten spelling. Example: mk, mac, mak for make. I can mk my bd.</b></p>	<p><b>Math Activities:</b> -Count on from a number other than 1 (Start at 8, 13, 28, 39, 97)</p> <p>-Put a small amount of cereal in a bowl. Count out 20 pieces. We just want them to write down the sounds that they hear.)</p> <p><b>Reading Activity:</b>          Read a book with animal characters with an adult. Draw a picture of your favorite character. Write the name of your favorite character.</p> <p>Have your child answer these key questions for fiction books;          -Who were the characters?          What was the setting? Remember that a pattern is something that repeats. See how many different patterns you can find. Look for different textures in your house or yard also. Texture is the way that something feels. The sidewalk has a rough or bumpy texture. Try putting a piece of paper over the texture and rubbing it with a crayon or pencil. The texture will appear on the paper. This is called a rubbing. Be careful to keep your crayon or pencil on the paper.</p>

Find and say some of the rhyming words together. Make up a fun rhyming sentence of your own. (Examples: The cat had a hat. The sun was fun. The fat cat sat on a mat.)
